

Checklist for Family Reunion Application For Dependent Parents

1. Application form fully completed and signed by the applicant.
2. One recent passport-size photograph with clear background.
3. Valid passport with validity of at least 15 months.
4. "Nulla Osta" (No Objection certificate) in original, issued by competent Questura in Italy. Kindly note that the "Nulla Osta" is valid only for a period up to six months from date of issue. The "Nulla Osta" will have to be renewed on expiry.
5. Discrepancy, if any, in the names of the applicant/s on the "Nulla Osta" and the passport/s, should be corrected to correspond with the name on the passport.
6. Photocopy of the passport (first page) of the person who has applied for the "Nulla Osta" in Italy. If available, also of the old passport.
7. Photocopy of the "Permesso di soggiorno" (Permit of stay), should not be expired.
8. Verification of original documents and of the Italian translation of Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificates, Ration Cards, Certificate of Family relationship & Certificate of Dependent Relationship.
9. Family Book (photocopy) .
10. Original birth certificate of the son/daughter residing in Italy, issued by the Registrar of Births and Deaths, clearly mentioning the registration number, along with translation in Italian language , both duly attested by the Under Secretary, Home Department.
11. Affidavit from parents stating the name of all the children (even if not living together), their date of birth and current residential address in China or abroad.
12. A parent is considered dependent on the son/daughter in Italy when he/she does not receive any income in China and does not have other children in China. Even if he/she receives minimum pension, he/she must provide proof of having received some remittance of money for a reasonable period of time from the family member in Italy. Kindly provide original bank account passbook of the applicant/s and remittance certificates from Italy (mandatory) and China. Official documents should also be submitted in case the parent/s own property in China and are receiving any income thereof.
