

Checklist for Family Reunion Application For Children

1. Visa Application form fully completed and signed by the applicant.
2. One recent passport-size photograph with clear background.
3. Valid passport with validity of at least 15 months.
4. "Nulla Osta" (No Objection certificate) in original, issued by competent Questura in Italy. Kindly note that the "Nulla Osta" is valid only for a period up to 6 months from date of issue. The "Nulla Osta" will have to be renewed on expiry.
5. Discrepancy, if any, in the names of the applicant/s on the "Nulla Osta" and the passport/s, should be corrected to correspond with the name on the passport.
6. Photocopy of the passport (first page) of the person who has applied for the "Nulla Osta" in Italy. If available, also of the old passport.
7. Photocopy of the "Permesso di soggiorno" (Permit of stay), should not be expired. If parents are all in Italy, both permit of stay should be submitted.
8. Verification of original documents and of the Italian translation of Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Certificate of Family Relationship and Approval letter from the person who detains the custody.
9. Family Book (photocopy).

Supporting Documents

1. Certified copy of the divorce certificate.
2. Death Certificate.
3. Consent to expatriation by the other parent abroad and copy of the residence permit, wherever he/she is resident or consent to expatriation by the person who detains the custody of the adopted.
